- 41-01E Cut Square Nails, 1-1/2"
- 41-01F Cut Square Nails, 1-3/4"
- 41-02A Cut Square Nail Fragments
 Fragments of cut square nails too incomplete to classify.
- 42-01A Forged Square Nails, Rose Headed
 Rose headed; shank tapers slightly toward tip equally on all sides;
 cross-section square; thickness irregular; broken tip.
- 42-02A Forged Square Nails
 Asymmetrically round heads and upper 2/3 of shank; lower 1/3 of shank square; thickness varies; clinched.

Beads (43-00 and 44-00)

- 43-01A Tubular Drawn Beads, Faceted Variety 1
 Cylindrical; ends slightly tapered; clear; transparent; complex,
 having three or more elements, in this specimen; clear, then milky
 white, then clear elements; facets form parallelogram.
- 43-01B Tubular Drawn Beads, Faceted Variety 2
 Cylindrical; dark blue; transparent; simple, only one element; facets hexagonal. Munsell 7.5 PB 2/8.
- 43-01C Tubular Drawn Beads, Faceted Variety 3
 Cylindrical; dark blue; transparent; compound elements, light blue inner layer, dark blue outer layer. Munsell 7.5 PB 4/12.
- 43-01D Tubular Drawn Beads, Faceted Variety 4
 Same as 43-01B except smaller overall size.
- 43-01E Tubular Drawn Beads, Faceted Variety 5
 Same as 43-01D except has compound elements, with light blue inner layer. Munsell 7.5 PB 4/12.
- 43-01F Tubular Drawn Beads, Faceted Variety 6
 Same as 43-01E except has two light blue and two dark blue elements alternating, complex. Munsell 7.5 PB 4/12.
- 43-01G Tubular Drawn Beads, Faceted Variety 7
 Same as 43-01B except is dark green in color instead of blue.
- 43-01H Tubular Drawn Beads, Faceted Variety 8
 Same as 43-01G except the diameter of the hole is relatively larger forming a thin walled bead.
- 43-02A Tubular Drawn Beads, Rounded Variety 1
 Fragment; cylindrical; red; edges worn almost smooth.

- 43-02B Tubular Drawn Beads, Rounded Variety 2
 Torus shaped; deep blue; translucent; simple; Munsell 10 B 5/10 for two specimens; 5 PB 5/12 for one specimen.
- 44-01A Mandrel Wound, Rounded Variety 1
 Spherical; medium blue; transparent; simple; Munsell 10 BG 3/6.
- 44-01B Mandrel Wound, Rounded Variety 2 Spherical; white; opaque; simple.
- 45-01A Window Glass Fragment
 Fragment of a transparent flat sheet of glass.
- 45-02A Bottle Glass Fragments
 Thick, green; transparent; fragment; concave-convex cross-section
 transversally; tapering thickness longitudinally; small chips removed
 along some edges not intentional.
- 46-01A Small Iron Tinklers

 Small conical clapperless bells made from flat sheets of iron; probably made from a can.
- 46-02A Large Iron Tinklers
 Large clapperless bells; conical.
- 46-03A Iron Tinklers, Blanks
 Flat pieces of iron 1 mm thick; generally trapezoidal; identical to an unrolled tinkler.
- 47-01A Powder Flask Cap
 Cap portion of automatic powder charger; center hole 8 mm wide; two
 other holes along medial axis 3.5 mm wide; one 2 mm wide screw on
 upper lateral edge milled; diameter of inside of flask is 34 mm.
- 48-01A Chain Link
 Forged; ends are flatter than sides; one end is open at the link;
 sides are bent in towards the center.
- 49-01A Adze

 Cutting edge convex; bevelled on one side only; greatest width at cutting end; head shows no evidence of pounding; cross-section slightly concave-convex; thinner towards all edges except head.
- 50-01A Iron Knife
 Pentagonal, with base not at right angle to either adjacent side; no side parallel; two shortest sides have been hammered, forming lip on both edges of each side; side with the most hammering is opposite the cutting edge; maximum width is between the medial ends of hammered sides. This specimen is referable to the tip portion of Bowie knife.
- 51-01A Iron Projectile Point Flat; triangular blade; side-notched; bevelled from shoulder to tip of edges; base thicker and broken straight across; pieces of wood adhere.
