VOL. 6 Pp. 251-389 The cordage was extremely well made. One specimen (#341-86, from the 0 to 6-inch level, Section A-3, Rockshelter Mno-455), is so fine and perfect that it had to be put under a 25 power microscope in order to make visible certain tiny imperfections and bits of foreign material in the twist which indicate native manufacture.

## Finished Bone

A slender awl was recovered from the 30 to 36-inch level of Section B, Rockshelter Mno-455, and a scapula saw was found in Section A-2 near the surface. This implement resembles one from the Karlo site (Riddell 1960: Figure 15a and page 28). Such saws may have been used for grass cutting. The serrated edge is polished.

#### Beads

Shelter Mno-455 yielded one olivella bead with truncated spire, one unmodified olivella, one blue glass bead, several opaque glass trade beads (brown outside, with a white portion around the hole), one thin bone bead, 0.4 cm in diameter, and a long bead, 3 cm in length, made from a section of one of the long bones of a small mammal.

## Charcoal

Coffee cans of charcoal were collected from the 6 to 24-inch level in Section B, Mno-455, and again in the 54 to 60-inch level. It would be desirable to have this material C14 dated, since the lower levels of Section B were undisturbed. Samples were also taken from Mno-472, Trench 2, 21-inch level, 24 to 36-inch level, 32-inch level, and 42 to 54-inch level. Flecks of charcoal occurred through the fill of both shelters. There were also large and small lenses. Charcoal samples were taken from the latter.

# Faunal Remains

Bird and animal bone was found in all levels of all sections of Mno-455. The dryness of this shelter insured excellent preservation. The material which was identifiable has been sorted by Marcus Buchanan of the Department of Zoology, University of California, Los Angeles. A list of species and Mr. Buchanan's comments are included in "Appendix 3."

# Plant Remains

Both food plants and utility plants were identified and are listed in "Appendix 1." Identifications were made by Mr. Lyle Pyatt, Department of Botany, University of California, Los Angeles.
